

Connecting Android Devices

Our network supports any device that can authenticate using 802.1x authentication.

Since Android devices come in many different flavors, joining the Wi-Fi network might look a little bit different on one device vs another.

In order to connect to our network, select the "CRPUSD" network, and then enter the following pieces of information:

EAP Method: **PEAP**

Phase 2 Authentication: **MSCHAPv2**

Certificate: **Do Not Validate**

Identity: **Your district username (e.g. john.smith, jane_smith, b.smithpopadopoulos, etc)**

Password: **Your district password**

Additionally, some devices may need:

Domain: **crpusd.net**
